VERSE

C Esus4 Am G
 I like the way that our time intertwines
 C Esus4 Dm G
 I want to design each day so we can meet
 C Esus4 Dm G
 Each word a seed that's hoping to grow—no need to hurry. Let's take it slow
 Dm G

REPEAT CHORUS

C Esus4 Dm G
 I like the shape of the thoughts in your mind
 C Esus4 Dm G
 You've got the kind of edge that I seem to need
 C Esus4 Dm G
 And if you feel the world doesn't care-- I'll send a message. You'll know I'm here. Oh...
